Did you know?

One in four children (who struggled with language at age five) did not reach the expected standard in English at the end of primary school, while one in five did not reach the expected standard in maths.

In 2019, only 19% of children with speech, language and communication needs achieved the expected level in reading, writing and maths at the end of primary school compared with 65% of all pupils.

The programme

The term 'early language' can be used to cover a number of different ages and stages from birth onwards. For the purposes of this programme, we will concentrate on the classroom/school environment, with a focus on providing;

- An understanding of a working model of language through which to observe children's language development through the primary years, and beyond.
- An understanding of the stages of 'typical' language development concentrating on the expected milestones that occur during primary years.
- Practical classroom skills and techniques for quality first teaching in YR and KS1 that will create skilled and confident classroom practitioners and improve outcomes for all children.
- Practical ways and tools to identify children who may not be developing language skills as expected. Ways to support those children in class, and in cases where more targeted
