Each session will include a researcher-led discussion of the ideas underpinning each research concept, followed by a teacher-led workshop exploring ways of operationalising these ideas into practice.

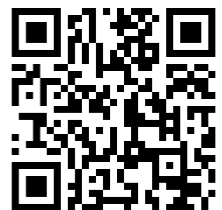
